“This I say then, walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.” -Galatians 5:16

In Galatians 5, the Apostle Paul compels believers to walk, be led, and live in the Spirit. He also teaches us in Romans 8 that the power of living out the Christian life is the working of the Holy Spirit. The Spirit works in the believer to conform them to the image of Christ to produce the fruits of the Spirit. He does this through filling God's people who participate in the Spiritual disciplines given to the church such as reading, meditation, prayer, and fasting. By expansive exploration of key biblical passages, testimonies, and practical applications, this year promises significant growth in your spiritual maturity through healthy disciplines with the Holy Spirit.

Apologetics

We are thrilled to offer you the first course of a planned series on apologetics! Apologetics is the practical and academic side to prepare you to “...be ready always to give an answer to every man that asketh you a reason of the hope that is in you...” (1 Peter 3:15 KJV) There are logical ways to understand the truth of God's Word, to engage the people in our culture and to draw them into the kingdom. This series will introduce basic questions about religion and Christianity, such as, “Is there even a God?”, “If Jesus is real, is He the Christ – the Son of the living God?” and, “is the Bible actually the inspired and inerrant Word of God?” Apologetics comes to life with the evidence, credibility, and precision of the Christ, the Scriptures, and the Way.
